

DRAFT SLEP 2013: Re-Exhibition Plan

Purpose of the re-exhibition

The purpose of the re-exhibition is to give the community the opportunity to comment on the changes that were made to the draft SLEP 2013 as a result of the original exhibition of the draft LEP in 2011. The re-exhibition also provides a further opportunity to comment on the draft plan prior to its finalisation later this year.

CCB meeting prior to exhibition

Council resolved on 24th August 2011 to meet with SLEP Review Group, CCBs, Chambers of Commerce and interested groups to discuss exhibition process prior to re-exhibition.
