## Huskisson & Woollamia Community Voice

### General Meeting Minutes Monday 14 April 2008

Meeting commenced at 7.10pm with 32 persons present.

#### General Business

##### 1 Presentation by Leigh Harris of the Jervis Bay Marine Park (JBMP):

- The JBMP zoning plan is currently being reviewed
- The Zoning Plan was first declared in October 2002
- The JBMP has multiple uses - to conserve marine biodiversity , to provide for recreational use and to preserve ecological processes
- After 5 years of the marine park existence -its still early days - positive signs are Grey Nurse sharks returning, some other species recovering
- Aquaculture in the Bay discussed
- Impact of development along the surrounding edge of Jervis Bay (especially Vincentia) was discussed
- Boat harbour and marina discussed
- Cap on charter fishing placed in plan

##### 2 Presentation by Graeme Gibson

DCP54 allows for 4 storey high development on the South side of Owen Street and 3 storeys on the northern side with a height bonus for lot consolidation.

Graeme showed a four minute video of a simulation along Owen Street of future development of the Huskisson CBD including a 5 storey development on the southern side at the western end and a 3 storey development on the RSL carpark block. The video showed scale and perspective of buildings and lead to much discussion.

##### 3 Presentation by Lesley Sanders of Shoalhaven Action Campaign (SAC)

- Discussed reasons for SAC existing and SCC approach to development
- Decision making process of Council and the record of ignoring Council staff advice
- Sale of public land discussed in closed session of council
- Discussed SCC code of conduct
- Over 1000 persons attended public meetings at Huskisson and Ulladulla in May/ June 2007 –leading to SAC's formation
- SAC has a constitution –refer website [www.shoalaction.org.au](http://www.shoalaction.org.au)
- Has southern, central and northern branches in the Shoalhaven area
- SAC is supporting candidates in the next local government election with the aim of changing the Council

**Minutes of the HWCV March meeting were accepted.**

**Treasurers Report** – balance is \$2203

**Rabbit Control** in Huskisson – training sessions are planned to be held at Moona Creek reserve on 19/5, 2/6 and 5/6 – poison baits to be supplied by Council – contact Meg Bishop for further details

**Anti-social behaviour** discussed at length –including alleged attack on triathlete in Huskisson over triathlon weekend. **Action** Alan Burrows to discuss in PACT forum and request Kyle Stewart to speak to HWCV meeting again. - Emphasised that all incidents be reported to NSW Police.

- **Coastline Management Study** – there is a workshop for residents to be held at Callala from 2.00 – 5.00pm on May 7. – ( covers coastline planning matters).
- Steve Murphy requested members to make submissions to Council regarding DCP 57, DCP100 and SPP5 – regarding dual occupancy and minimum lot size for subdivision – submissions close on April 24.
- Invitation to Maca was discussed – no objections to HWCV sending him an invite.
- Leslie Lockwood discussed the Husky Pub DA– HWCV submission sent February, recommendation to Council from staff is that Council determine DA, document on SCC website is inadequate – insufficient information.

## **Huskisson Bypass – summary**

November 2007 – report from staff to Council and voted in support by Council

8/4/08 – further report indicated 50% of route in National Park and 50% is crown land – council voted to support ongoing investigation and planning. – total area affected is approx 800 x 30 metres in area ie 2.4 hectares
