 - i. The height limits are 3 & 4 storeys. NO bonus
 - ii. Consideration of a half Storey Bonus based on the detail provided by Council
 - c. Overall meeting resolution on DCP54 Amdt4, by show of hands, was for: a max of 3-storey (nth), and 4-storey (sth), with no height bonuses ; building profile articulation must commence after the 2nd storey ; and that the flawed workshop process should be re-visited with genuine intent.
