**Advice - 1080 Fox Baiting Program  
27 August to 14 December 2018**

Shoalhaven City Council is conducting a fox control program in your area using 1080 poison baits from Monday 27 August to Friday 14 December 2018 at the Sewage Treatment Plant at «STP»

The 1080 fox baiting program will be undertaken strictly in accordance with the conditions of the Pesticide Control (1080 Bait Products) Order 2017. 1080 poisoning notices will be erected at each baited site and at the end of the baiting period, remaining baits will be collected and disposed of accordingly.

The baiting program has been designed to minimise the risk to non-target species (both domestic and native) and minimise disruption to residents who own dogs. As a result of the program, significant benefits accrue to farmers, landowners with small livestock and the significant populations of Australian native animals in this area.

Council is seeking your cooperation to protect you and your neighbour's domestic pets during this baiting period. **You need to be aware that domestic animals such as dogs and cats are susceptible to 1080 poison and may be affected.** During this period, please ensure that your domestic animals and domestic animals in your care are locked up, restrained or under effective control at all times.
