The Amendment to Chapter G13 of Shoalhaven DCP 2014 seeks to action the matters resolved in a Councillor Notice of Motion dated 18 December 2018 (MIN18.993). Chapter G13 applies to land where dual occupancy, multi dwelling housing, multi dwelling housing (terraces), attached dwellings, semi-detached dwellings, manor houses, integrated housing development, residential flat buildings, shop top housing, seniors housing, boarding houses, group homes and hostels are permissible with development consent.

You are encouraged to view the DCP Amendment and to have your say on the proposed changes. Submissions should be made in writing and should include Council's reference 60371E.
